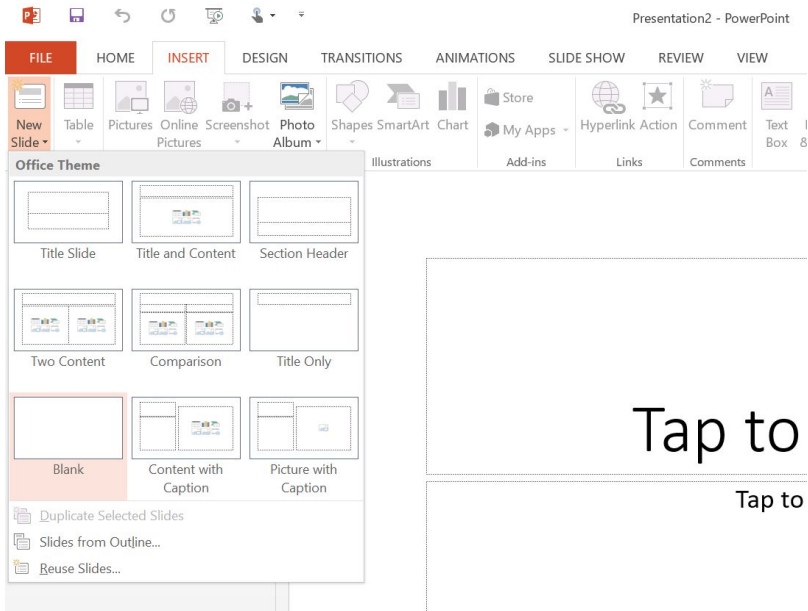


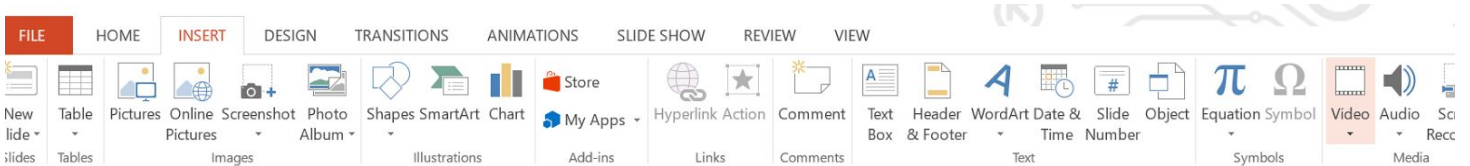
Video Modeling on PC How-To

Microsoft Power Point

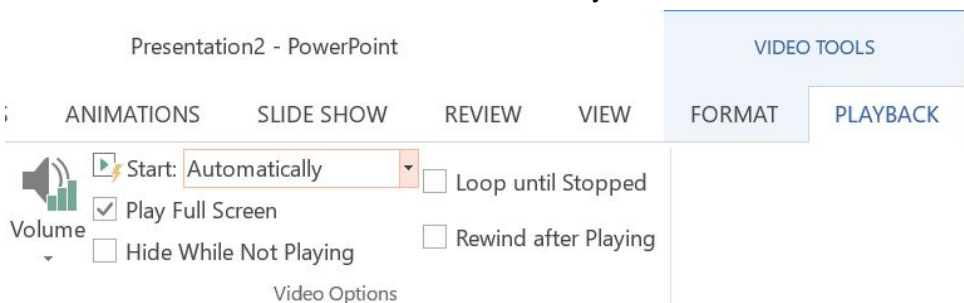
1. Open a new Power Point presentation.
2. Insert a few blank slides.



3. On a blank slide select Insert, Video



4. Find your video either online or on your computer.
5. Click on the video. Under Video Tools> Playback, select Start: Automatically, and Play Full Screen

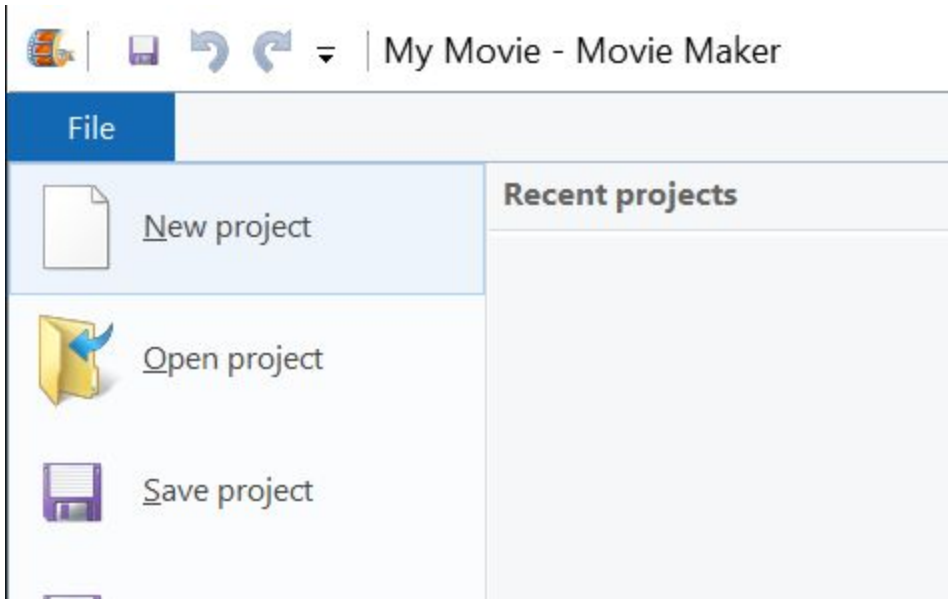


6. Continue steps 3-5 for the remainder of your videos.

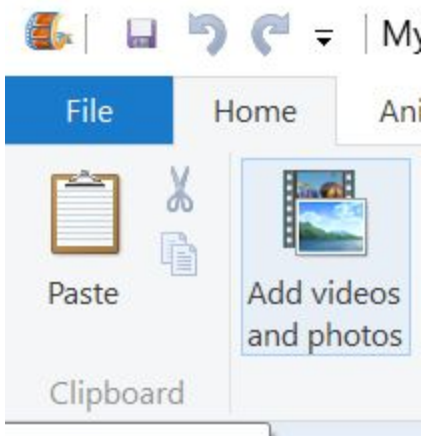
*You will need to click through the slides manually as you do the video model with your class/student.

Windows Movie Maker

1. Get the free download: <http://windows.microsoft.com/en-us/windows/movie-maker>
2. Open Movie Maker
3. Go to File> New Project

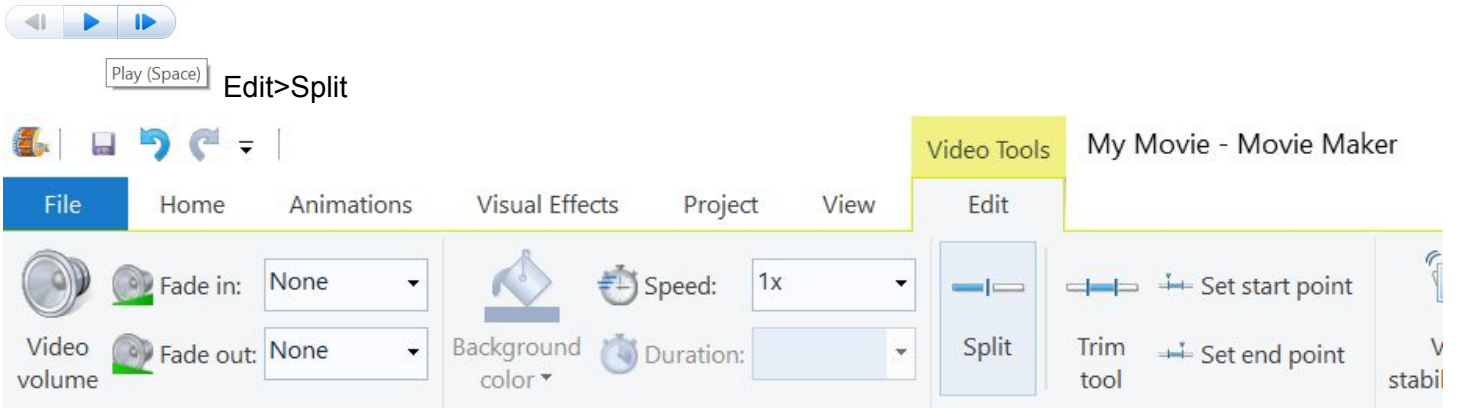


4. Go to Home> Add videos and photos and find the videos on your computer. Wait for them to load.

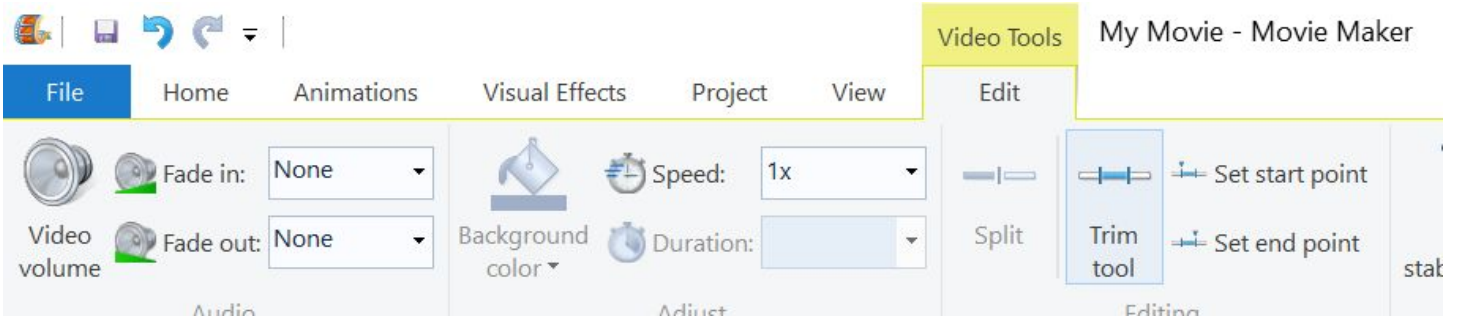


5. Need to edit the video?

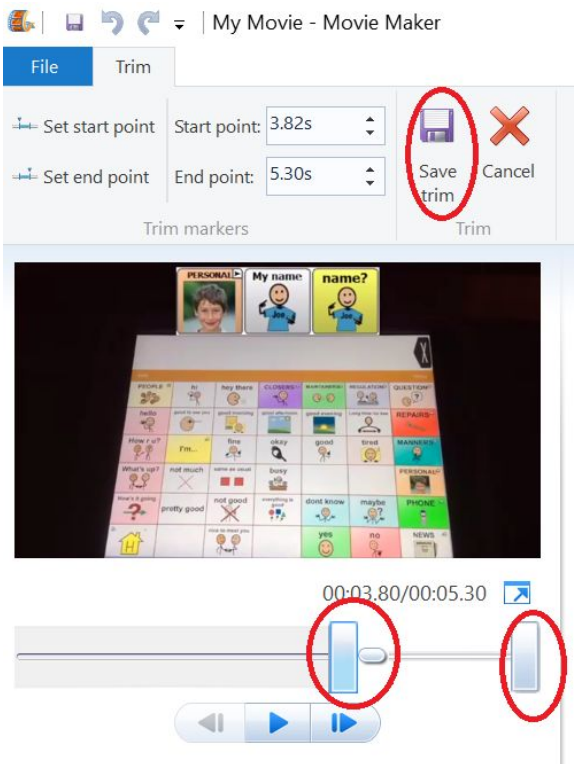
Split a video into smaller parts: Start your video, pause it at the spot you want to split the video.



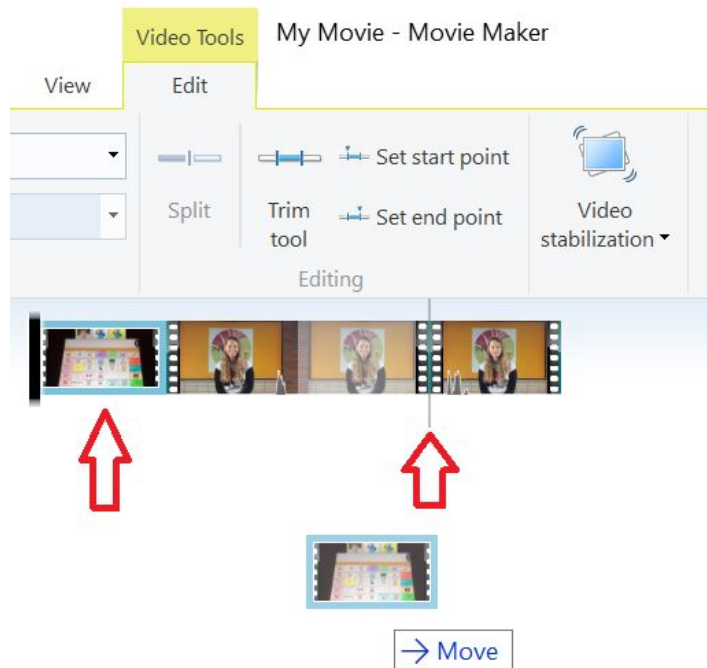
Trim a video to cut off parts: Select the video portion you would like to trim, Edit>Trim tool



Use the sliders to select the part for the video you want to keep. Then hit save.



Move video clips to a different place: select the video clip you want to move, click and drag it to the desired location
